What's the Problem?

- Some networks use unallocated IP address space
- That address space will soon be allocated
- This could be problematic

Which /8s?

- 1, 2, 3 (massive private use)
- 5 (Hamachi)
- 14 (PDN)
- 42 (HP Procurve 700wl etc...)
- 104 (Grid networking)

How does this affect operators?

- Enterprises may want/need to renumber
- ISPs **will** get support calls

What can operators do about it?

- Wait?
- Suggest using IPv6?
